I have very exciting news to share with you about my upcoming year in dance. JESSICA GAYNOR DANCE is off and running (as well as leaping, jumping and turning). We have welcomed four new dancers into the company and are now a company consisting of 4 women and 2 men, all with extraordinary talent.

More exciting news for Jessica Gaynor Dance, it has been chosen to participate in Gotham Arts Exchange's Mentoring Program for the 2009/2010 season. This representation will elevate the company to a more professional level through production value, publicity and additional performance opportunities, beginning with a performance slot in New York's prestigious APAP in January at the Skirball Center, and a shared 2-night concert in the Playhouse at Henry Street Settlement in downtown Manhattan. We hope you can attend many of these concerts and support the company's continued growth.

We have been busy in the studio working on Theory of Games, a new evening length piece, which takes its inspiration from puzzles. Dancers move into and out of formation to J.S. Bach's Musical Offering, creating a fluid and shifting sense of unity and disjunction, melding individual performances with larger ensemble compositions. The process of choreographing to such a giant piece of music has been a magnificent challenge for us all.

The company presented a preview of this new work at the Collaborations in Dance Festival at Triskelion Arts on August 21, to great success. Theory of Games will premiere in its entirety November 13-15 at Triskelion Arts, the company's home base in Brooklyn. L Magazine named the production a MUST SEE Fall Art Event in its September Fall Preview issue. This evening of dance is not to be missed, and we hope to see you at the show.
